Held under British Rowing Rules of Racing as adopted by Welsh Rowing.
2,250m downstream on the River Wye with BOATING IN NUMBER ORDER, which
hugely reduces waiting on the river in December!

Times will be LIVE, with medals awarded when the times have been confirmed.

Eights: Senior, Masters B+, J18, J16, J15

Low CRI/Beginners: Offered for coxed quads and other events will be banded as entries allow.

Masters entries to be made in “B+”, then will be grouped as possible.

Categories may be banded (in line with BROE2 data) depending on entries.

Please note that as river conditions can vary we reserve the right to change the length of the course, race upstream or withdraw certain categories for safety reasons. Coaches should ensure entrants are suitably experienced for the size & type of boat and the likely winter conditions before entering the crew.

Presentation medals will be awarded in ALL events where two or more boats start.

Open and Women’s Pennants will be awarded for:

- Fastest Crew (Eights)
- Fastest Crew (Fours)
- Fastest Crew (Quads)

Events with only one entry have three options, please select when entering in BROE:

- Race “Time Only” and receive a 50% refund
- Withdraw
- Promoted to a higher category to ensure a classification if available

Entries and payment to be made solely via BROE.
